


This morning there was an incredible development in the case of the Ten Little Soldiers. For anyone who missed the news, here is a summary of what happened six months ago.

The victims of the Soldier Island

Vera Claythorne: a former governess who comes to Soldier Island purportedly to serve as a secretary to Mrs. Owen. She was an intelligent and capable woman, but she also suffered from attacks of hysteria, and she felt guilty about the crime she committed.

Philip Lombard: a mysterious, confident, and resourceful man who seems to have been a mercenary soldier in Africa. His weakness was his chivalrous attitude toward women, particularly Vera. He could not think of her as a potential killer, and he underestimates her resourcefulness, which proves a fatal mistake.

Dr. Edward George Armstrong: a gullible, slightly timid doctor. He was a recovering alcoholic who had once accidentally killed a patient by operating on her while he was drunk. Armstrong, while professionally successful, had a weak personality.

William Henry Blore: a former police inspector. Blore was a well-built man whose experience often inspired others to look to him for advice. As a policeman, he was corrupt and framed a man named Landor at the behest of a criminal gang.

Ethel Rogers: Rogers's wife. Ethel was a frail woman, and the death of Tony Marston made her faint.











Thomas Rogers: the dignified butler. Rogers continued to be a proper servant even after his wife was found dead and the bodies began piling up. The recording accuses Rogers and his wife of letting their former employer die because they stood to inherit money from her.

General John Gordon Macarthur: the oldest and nicest guest. Macarthur was accused of sending a lieutenant, Arthur Richmond, to his death during the Great War because Richmond was his wife's lover.

Emily **Brent:** an old. ruthlessly religious woman who read her Bible every day. The recording accused Emily Brent of killing Beatrice Taylor, a servant whom she had fired upon learning that Beatrice was pregnant out of wedlock. Beatrice subsequently killed herself. Unlike the other on the Island, Emily Brent feels of her convinced own righteousness and did not express the slightest remorse for her actions

Anthony Marston: a rich, athletic, handsome youth. Tony Marston liked to drive recklessly and seemed to lack a conscience. He killed two small children in a car accident caused by his speeding, but shows no remorse.

Lawrence Wargrave: an intelligent Judge, who loved to send criminals to prison.

An incredible discovery

Lawrence Wargrave was a retired judge suspected of having wrongly sentenced Edward Seton to death; He was an intelligent and thoughtful man, which is why he often stood out within a group of people. On the island, after the first deaths, he had taken charge of the situation, analysing the suspects and devising hypotheses. Nobody expected him to be the killer on Soldier Island. This mornina. however, after finding his message, the police wondered why they had not understood it before. Judge Wargrave posed as a random quest who had been invited by a friend on the island, hiding his true plan. He had planned everything in detail: he had researched his ten victims, discovered their darkest secrets, their weaknesses and he knew how to exploit them. The first murders were easy to carry out, but slowly the number of survivors decreased and everyone began to suspect everyone. What better way to get off the suspect list than to fake his own With the help of Dr death? 
Who will be the writer of the century? Many think it will be Agatha Christie, ring who is this but Why?




